

High Level Dialogue Checklist

- Make sure your organisation follows the ITUC news, you can subscribe on the first page of the ITUC website: <http://www.ituc-csi.org>. You can also follow the ITUC on Facebook and Twitter.

- Make sure your national government knows what unions wants for the United Nations High Level Dialogue in New York in September 2013:
 - That migrants need decent work and protection just like any other workers.
 - That the UN normative framework should be the body to deal with migration.
 - That the UN gives the ILO a key role in governing the issues of migration.The full statement is available on the ITUC website: <http://www.ituc-csi.org/migration>.

- Make sure your government has ratified ILO Conventions 143 and 97. If not – lobby them to do so!

- Lobby your government to make sure its delegation to the High Level Dialogue has civil society and union reps included. Notify the ITUC if you have unionists included in the delegation.
